



Boarding Information and Rates

Cage-free boarding is limited. Because dogs stay with staff in a cage-free environment, staff need to be sure dogs know them, are confident and have great impulse control.

CAGE-FREE OVERNIGHTS

- **Limited** to dogs we know from day care who have slept outside a crate for over one year.
- Participating dogs **must** be spayed / neutered; no exceptions.
- Cage-Free boarding requires a lot of confidence and impulse control.
- Dogs **MUST** arrive by 11:00 AM Monday-Friday on the day of boarding (day care will be charged for that day), **on Friday for weekend stays**
- Food must be individually wrapped by meal
- Credit Card **MUST** be on owner profile so you can be checked out at the end of your stay
- Nothing else is required

Cost: \$80 per night (\$86 per night during peak periods: Christmas/New Year weeks; Spring Break season; Thanksgiving, Fourth of July, Memorial Day and Labor Day weekends)

What's included:

- Full Day Care Classic (Day Care Plus for an additional \$10/day) after first day
- Individual feeding
- Lots of attention
- No extra charge for walks, administering medication, etc.
- Please only bring food – no beds, toys, or dishes are necessary

Dogs may be picked up on weekdays prior to 6:30 PM and on weekends between 9 AM and 5 PM.



Rex's Place Boarding House

Our kennels offer all our guests an individual space of their own. During the day, they'll play with some of their friends or go on a couple of walks to shake their legs out.

- Open 365 days per year
- Kennel boarding dogs must be dropped off between 4:00 and 6:00 PM. Dogs who are dropped off prior to 4 PM will be billed for day care on their first day.
- You can pick your dog up on any weekday during our designated pickup hours, 8:00 – 11:00 am and 4:00 - 6:00 pm. Dogs picked up after 11 am will incur a \$31 late fee. No pickups after 6:00 pm.
- Guests have the option to participate in Day Care Classic (M-F), which reduces stress, eliminates boredom and wears them out, ensuring peaceful rest throughout the night, at no extra charge.
- In order to make sure we won't have any problems with digestion, please bring your dog's own food in individually wrapped meals. You can also bring: a non-destructible, non-squeaky toy
- Medications are administered at no charge
