

Boarding Information and Rates

Our boarding is unique...small in size where dogs stay with staff in a cage-free environment. Staff needs to be sure dogs know them, so cage-free boarding is only available to dogs who attend daycare at least twice a month.

CAGE-FREE OVERNIGHTS

In order to make a reservation, the Consent to Board Form must be completed and submitted. A non-refundable deposit of \$80.00 and charge card number are required to hold your reservation. The balance for your stay will be charged on the day of pickup.

- Dogs MUST arrive by 11:00 AM on the day of boarding
- Dogs are only accepted for cage-free boarding M-F
- Food must be individually wrapped by meal

Going on vacation? Why not have your dog go on one, too? Our new kennels offer all our guests an individual space of their own. During the day, they'll play with some of their friends or go on a couple of walks to shake their legs out.

Features of the Rex's Place Boarding House:

- We will be open 365 days per year, meaning you can pick your dog up on any day during our designated pickup hours, 7:00 am – 12:00 pm. Dogs picked up after 12 will incur a 1/2 day charge. No pickups after 5:00 pm.
- We are located in the Evanston's Hill Arts District, easily accessible to our entire North Shore service area
- Dogs who stay with us have the option to participate in daycare (M-F), which reduces stress, eliminates boredom and wears them out, ensuring peaceful rest throughout the night.
- In order to make sure we won't have any problems with digestion, please bring your dog's own food. You can also bring:
 - Non-destructible, non-squeaky toys
 - Bedding/towels
- Medications (which will be administered at no charge)
